Health overview

The Andrews Labor Government's 2018-19 Budget is investing **\$2.1** billion in health services, programs and agencies to ensure all Victorians have access to quality healthcare close to home.

This includes:


- \$2.04 billion to deliver more hospital care to Victorian patients
- \$24.3 million for a range of public health, prevention and medical research activities to create healthier Victorian communities.

In addition, the Victorian Budget 2018-19 is supporting health infrastructure projects worth **\$1.2 billion** right across the State.

Over the past four years, the Andrews Labor Government has invested an additional \$10.7 billion in health services and infrastructure.


Acute Health Budget Output Growth


■ In 2018-19, **\$14.11 billion will be invested** in acute health services — an increase of 7.5 per cent on 2017-18.

billion.















Health & Ambulance Regional Investment 2015/16 - 2018/19
