




Investing in Ambulance Services

- The 2018-19 Budget is investing a further \$55.1 million over four years
- The Ambulance Services budget will increase to \$1.08 billion an increase of 55 per cent over four years




Improving Ambulance Response Times




- The Government's record investment in ambulance services has seen a demonstrable improvement in response times. The latest quarter (Q3, 2017-18) saw Code 1 response times reach 83 per cent the highest Q3 result in nine years.
- Code 1 response performance improvement is on track to, for the first time, meet the statewide Code 1 response performance target of 85 per cent.

Delivering Better Clinical Outcomes

- Investments in and reform of our ambulance services are delivering better response times and importantly, also better clinical outcomes
- The revised clinical response model is ensuring more paramedics are able to get to more life-threatening emergencies, faster.
- Paramedics have attended a record number of cardiac arrest patients.
- Average response times for patients experiencing cardiac arrest have hit record performance.
- Survival for patients in a shockable rhythm to hospital discharge is at its highest level.
