

2018-19 – More support with new funding

The 2018/19 Budget will deliver \$43.6 million of new funding giving a total of \$84.6 million investment to build on the cultural diversity that is one of our state's greatest strengths, including:

- African Communities Action Plan: \$8.6 million
- Combating Violent Extremism: \$14.1 million
- Multicultural Community Infrastructure Program: \$17.1 million
- Multicultural festivals and events program: \$1.4 million
- Translation Services : \$500,000
- Multicultural Safety Ambassadors: \$300,000
