
\$5.4 million investment in Equality portfolio

The 2018/19 Budget initiatives for LGBTI Victorians include:

- A new **Pride Events and Festivals Fund** \$2 million over four years
 - Includes funding of \$600,000 over three years for Midsumma.
- Supporting LGBTI Victorians in our healthcare system: capacity to support trans and gender diverse people -\$3.4 million over four years:
 - two new gender clinics
 - skill development and training for healthcare professionals
 - a peer support program.



Other Victorian government portfolio targeted LGBTI investment examples






Legislative reform

This Government has a proud record of **legislative reform** to make Victoria fairer for LGBTI people, including:

- Repealing the offence of intentionally infecting someone with HIV
- Expunged historical convictions for homosexual activity
- Adoption equality for LGBTI Victorians
- Making it easier for LGBTI couples to register their domestic relationships
- Establishing powers to investigate and act on 'gay conversion therapy'
- Ensuring trans people can register their sex without being forced to divorce.



Equality Highlights: Pride Centre

- The Government is proud to support the establishment of the Victorian Pride
 Centre with foundation funding of \$15 million for its design and construction.
- The Pride Centre is being developed by and for LGBTI communities through the independent Victorian Pride Centre Limited (VPC) led by June Munro AO.
- In January 2018, I announced the winning design for the Pride Centre which will form part of a revitalised St Kilda precinct.





Equality Highlights: LGBTI Community Grants Program

- The 2016/17 Budget invested \$4 million over four years for an LGBTI Community Grants Program.
- The 2017/18 round announced in April 2018 -18 organisations sharing \$700,000.
- In February 2018, I announced that we will establish a groundbreaking LGBTI leadership program with Leadership Victoria costing \$200,000 per annum.



Equality Highlights: Rural and Regional LGBTI Roadshow

- The **Rural and Regional LGBTI Roadshow** funded from the \$2.5 million allocated in the Combatting Homophobia Initiative
- A co-designed project, it has visited more than 23 towns, hosted over 220 engagement activities with over 2500 attendees.
- In April 2018 a first ever Community of Practice brought together nearly 80 LGBTI regional and rural leaders.
