Youth Affairs portfolio

- Every young person needs opportunities and support to reach their potential
- We are developing a new youth policy to build stronger youth engagement in government policy & decision making in Victoria
- We are delivering programs that support youth engagement and participation in community and economic life



Youth participation and engagement

Delivering on 2015-16 initiatives

- Programs funded in the 2015-16 Budget are well underway:
 - round 1 of the rural and regional engagement grants program is supporting better representation of young people in local government decision making in rural Victoria
 - YACVic's regional presence is being established in Warrnambool & Swan Hill
 - new scout and guide programs have commenced, focusing on building social inclusion in areas of social and economic disadvantage, and in culturally diverse communities
 - following feedback from youth consultations, new programs are being developed to support and reconnect young people at risk of disengagement

Building supportive and culturally strong communities

- \$875,000 in the 2016-17 Budget will support young people most in need of assistance, through a mentoring program to foster cultural identity and build resilience in young Aboriginal people
- \$2.2 million is also being provided over two years for the Koori Youth Justice Program to:
 - strengthen state-wide capacity to deliver Community Based Koori
 Youth Justice initiatives
 - provide new area based program support
 - provide new prevention and early intervention brokerage packages
