
### BETTER FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT NEW FRAMEWORKS

- Standing Directions of the Minister for Finance 2016 requiring:
  - modernised financial management
  - stronger accountability for agency management such as CFOs
  - controls against fraud and corruption
  - better planning
  - public attestation
- Performance Management Framework:
  - adopts PAEC's recommendations in 118th Report
  - includes rules and guidance for government and public sector planning, budgeting, service delivery, performance monitoring, reporting and accountability

### BETTER FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT FURTHER REFORMS

- Changes to improve departmental planning and resource allocation, including:
  - realigning outputs to objectives
  - disaggregating outputs
  - improving performance measures
- Financial Management Act 1994 changes to:
  - improve accountability for financial management
  - remove outdated and inefficient requirements





## WORKSAFE VICTORIA OHS PERFORMANCE

- Average of 41,600 inspector visits per year


#### Claims per million hours worked

- Innovative client centred model of support




