

## Consumer Affairs Victoria – activity overview

- 29 Acts of Parliament administered
- 478,500 Victorians provided information & advice
- 3 million+ visits to CAV's website
- 9,600 inspections, compliance monitoring & enforcement activities
- Over 541,000 registration & licensing transactions
- 35,500 financial counselling sessions
- Advocacy services for 6,400 vulnerable Victorians



## 2016-17 Budget Initiatives

- \$33.3m for Victorians in need
  - Financial counselling (\$7.9m)
  - Specialist Tenancy and Consumer Service (\$3.4m)
  - Affordable housing grants (\$22m)
