



METROPOLITAN TRAIN PATRONAGE & PTV FORECAST

GETTING ON WITH IT

- \$20 BILLION DOLLAR BUDGET INVESTMENT
 - Largest investment in public transport in Victoria's history
- START CONSTRUCTION OF MELBOURNE METRO IN 2018
 - \$1.5B for preconstruction works and detailed design to commence immediately (3,500 jobs)
- REMOVE 50 LEVEL CROSSINGS OVER 8 YEARS
 - \$2.4B to get started, 20 Funded in first budget (4,500 jobs)
- UPGRADE OF THE CRANBOURNE / PAKENHAM LINES
 - No level crossings between Dandenong and the City
 - All trains to be high capacity next generation trains
- ROLLING STOCK STRATEGY
 - Order of E-Class trams increased to 70
 - 5 Xtrapolis Trains
 - 37 next generation high capacity trains
 - 21 V/Locity Carriages
 - Refurbishment of trains and trams.
 - Supporting 10,000 jobs







OPENING OF REGIONAL RAIL LINK

Commission the \$4 billion dollar project funded by Labor

BENDIGO METRO

 \$2M to improve connections between railway stations in the Bendigo area.

MURRAY BASIN RAIL

Finalisation of business case and \$220M to commence delivery


MELBOURNE METRO

 Delivery of a project that will unlock significant capacity for public transport and offer better connection for regional passengers

REGIONAL NETWORK DEVELOPMENT PLAN

- Comprehensive plan for public transport in regional Victoria
- Ensuring that investment in rolling stock, infrastructure and services is considered together





OTHER BUDGET 15/16 INITIATIVES

MERNDA RAIL EXTENSION

We will extend the South Morang line to Mernda with two new stations

HUNTINGDALE STATION

 \$7M for a new bus interchange for services to Monash

BUSES

\$100M for additional bus services

HOMESAFE

 A \$50M trial of overnight public transport services on Friday and Saturday nights

FLINDERS STREET STATION

 \$100M to clean up and restore Flinders Street Station

TAXIS

\$4M for Taxi Hardship Fund
