This Wednesday 23 August, public hearings will begin for the next stage of the parliamentary inquiry into the Victorian Government's rate capping policy.

The inquiry is examining the outcome of the Victorian Government's rate capping policy on councils' viability, service impacts on local communities and impacts on the provision of local infrastructure.
