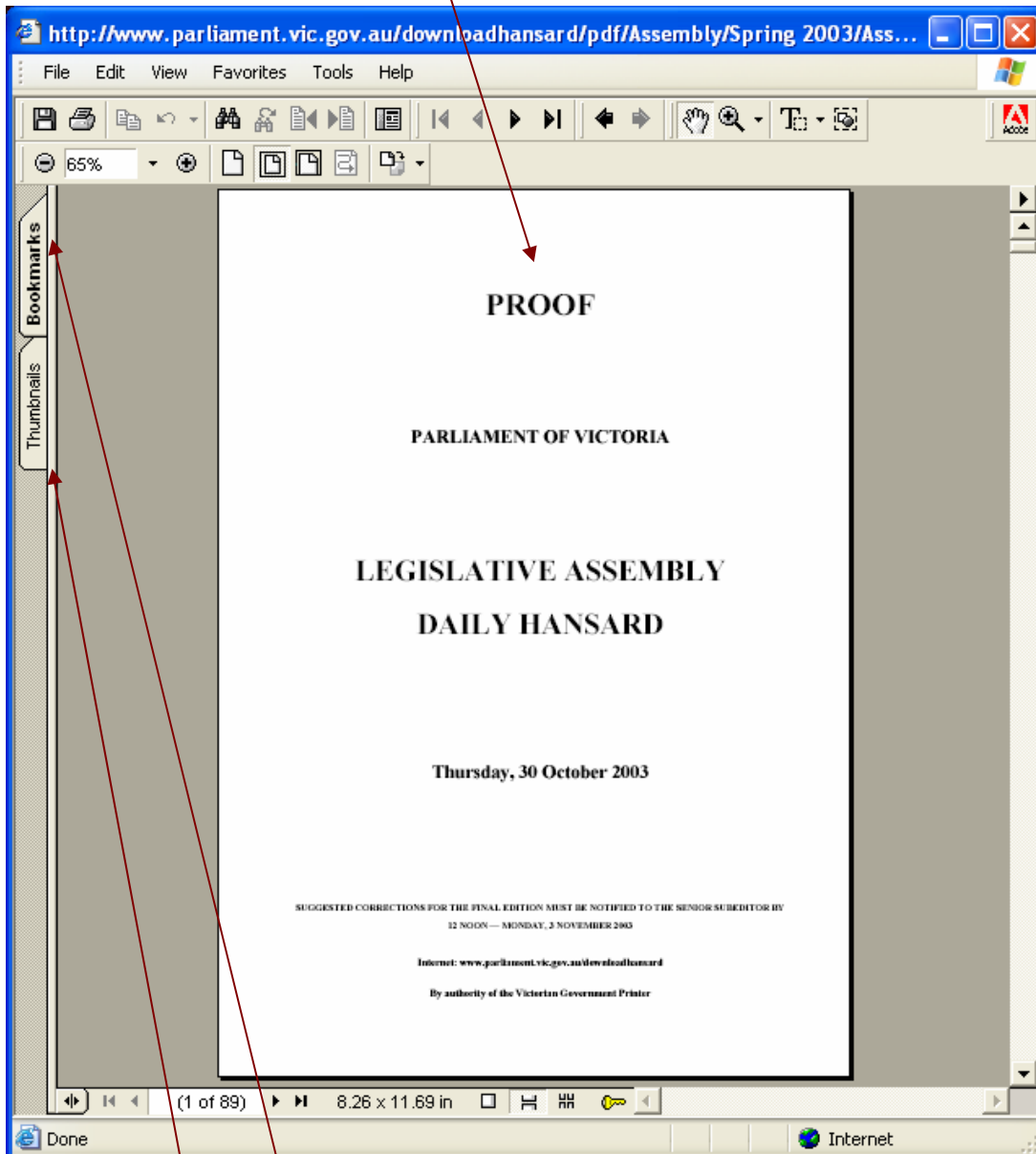
Because the **revised book** is a large document, you may wish to open up a single day's proceedings as this tends to download much faster.

If the revised book does not appear as a link in the right column, this means only the *Daily Hansard* is available. *Daily Hansard* is a proof version and must not be quoted as it is subject to revision.

If you wish to quote from *Hansard*, you should quote only from the revised book. The revised weekly *Hansard* is available on this site three to four working days after the end of the relevant sitting week.

Daily Hansard has "PROOF" written at the top of the document.

Daily Hansard must not be quoted as it is subject to revision.



Click the "Bookmarks" tab to view the document contents in a directory format. Then click on an item to go to that page.

Click on the "Thumbnails" tab to view a list of links to pages.

Once the Hansard document has downloaded, you can scroll down to view the contents page. This provides a useful snapshot of what happened in Victorian Parliament on that day (a single day's proceedings) or that week (the revised book).

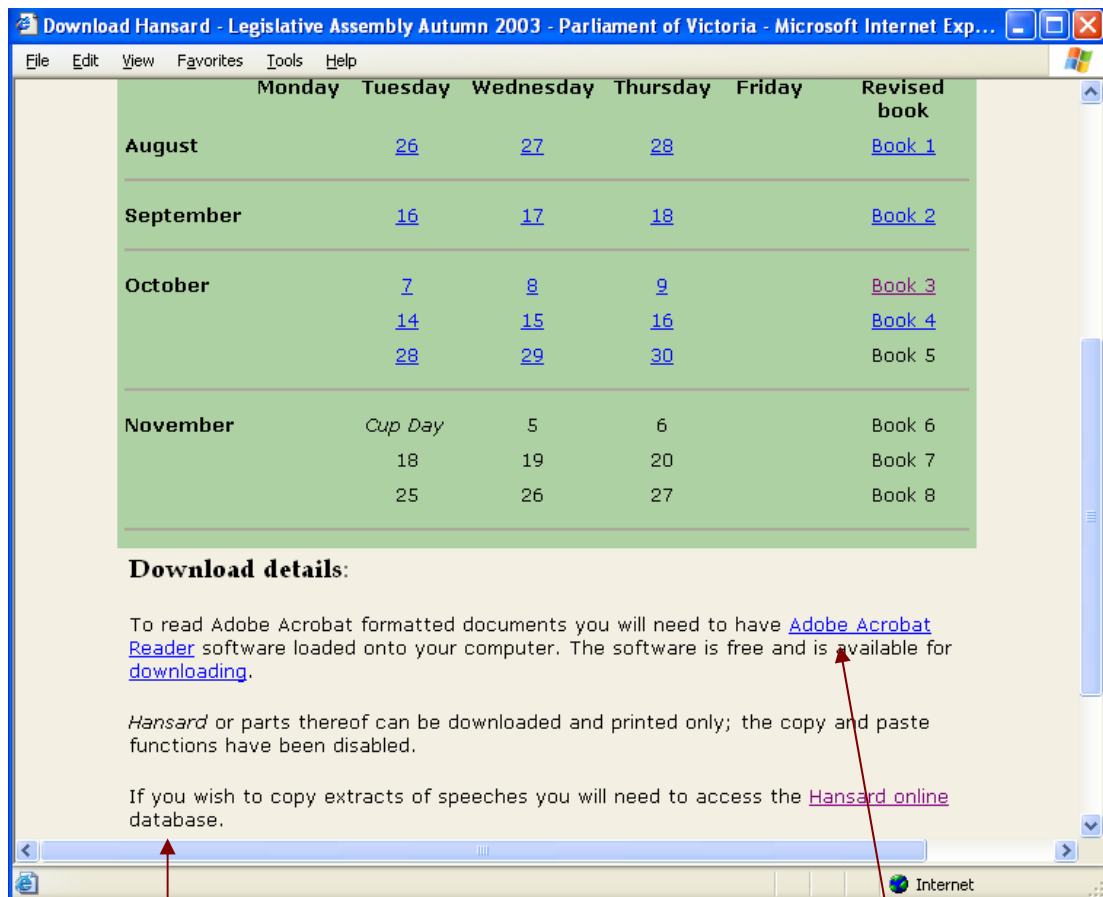
