

In regards to the music program at Werrimull P-12 School, we have faced the following challenges (and continue to):

- Staffing (we currently have one primary teacher who is confident teaching recorder and singing- notation)
- Choice (when given the choice as part of the elective program Secondary students did not choose music)
- The possibility of sharing a teacher is limited by the distance (approx. 70km from the nearest school)

In saying that, primary students have studied 2 units in the past 2 years; recorder and singing- notation. Senior Primary and Secondary students rely on digital resources such as Garage Band and Audacity to produce their own sounds; these tools are used in a range of classes.

The limitations listed above make it hard to offer a specialist program however aspects of 'music' are integrated into other areas of the curriculum.
