Road Safety Committee to hold Open Forum in Wodonga for Inquiry into Motorcycle Safety

Wednesday 30 November 2011

The Parliament of Victoria, Road Safety Committee, is conducting an Open Forum as part of its Inquiry into Motorcycle Safety.

The Inquiry into Motorcycle Safety has 11 terms of reference, covering a range of motorcycle safety issues, including:

- new initiatives to reduce motorcycle crashes and injuries;
- countermeasures to reduce the number and severity of motorcycle accidents;
- the changing face of motorcycling, including the uptake of motorcycles as an alternate form of transport;
- the attitude of motorcycle riders, and
- ways in which government and non-government sectors can work together to achieve motorcycle safety outcomes.

The Committee invites you to participate in the inquiry by attending an open forum on Wednesday 30 November 2011 between 12.30 and 2.00pm in the Boardroom, TAFESpace, 158 Lawrence Street, Wodonga.

Each person will have 10 minutes to discuss the issue of motorcycle safety with the Committee. The Committee encourages you to come along and have your say.

Please note – this will be a formal public hearing of the Committee, and as such, there are procedures that must be followed.
