



## **INQUIRY INTO THE VAGRANCY ACT 1966**

### **Discussion Paper**

The Scrutiny of Acts and Regulations Committee has been requested by the Victorian Parliament to inquire into the Vagrancy Act 1966. The purpose of the review is to consider the content and relevance of the Act, and whether it contains provisions that are unclear, redundant or ambiguous that require repeal, amendment or revision.

To assist with this, the Redundant Legislation Subcommittee of SARC has prepared a Discussion Paper containing preliminary recommendations and proposals for the Act on a clause-by-clause basis.

The Committee invites written submissions from the public and interested groups in relation to any, or all of the recommendations contained in the Discussion Paper. The Committee also welcomes further submissions from those who may have previously lodged submissions with the Committee.
