

Inquiry into Homelessness in Victoria – public hearing 9 September 2020

Ambulance Victoria response to question from Mr Barton on the dollar cost of treating a person experiencing homelessness:

In relation to the question from Mr Barton, the cost to treat but not transfer a patient is \$707.93 and the cost to treat and transfer a patient to hospital (emergency road Vic wide average) is \$1618.62.

Please note that there can be variance in these figures depending on the patient's specific needs at the time of arrival.
