





Hungarian physician who discovered, in 1847, that the incidence of puerperal fever could be drastically cut by <u>hand washing</u>.

Etiology, Concept and Prophylaxis of Childbed Fever - 1861








Autopsy to Delivery = Death








In 2003, appointed Director of Surgery at the <u>Bundaberg Base</u>

He was appointed despite having no specialist surgical qualifications.


Dr Jayant Patel – Bundaberg Hospital, Old



In *June 2010*, Patel was convicted of 3 counts of <u>manslaughter</u> and one case of <u>grievous bodily harm</u>, and sentenced to *seven years in jail*.

In *August 2012*, the conviction was rescinded by the full bench of the high court and a retrial was ordered due to tainting of the jury by 'highly emotive and prejudicial evidence that was irrelevant to the case".
