Hearing into capturing data on people using family violence set for Monday

The Legislative Assembly Legal and Social Issues Committee will hold a hearing on Monday 19 August as part of its inquiry into the collection of data about people who use family violence in Victoria.

The Committee is seeking input on the mechanisms for capturing data on the profile and volume of people using family violence in Victoria and what additional data could help achieve a full understanding of this cohort.

The Committee is also seeking to understand more about the barriers to collecting this data and how they can be overcome.

The hearing will be held from 9 am until approximately 5 pm and will include input from health data experts, government representatives from Corrections Victoria and Family Safety Victoria, health and welfare services and anti-violence organisations.
