To whom it may concern.

I Josephine Mary Mertens was admitted with mother to home as a newborn, on 3rd April 1952 and discharged on 21.2.53 and then re-admitted on 14.12.53 and then discharged on 22.11.54.

As you see i did not have a good start in life, being put in a home, not much attention , but just letting u know that i used to cry a lot at night and got no attention from staff members.. as told by my mother. Between 1945-1970 Medical Journal of Australia – reported Experiments with influenza Vaccines – conducted by Walter& Eliz Hall Institute in the 1950 to children under 3 years of age. Staff from babies home responsible for go ahead of treatment. , but just letting u know now while i was at St Joseph’s baby home i used to cry a lot a night, and never got any attention. as told by my mother.
