My name is Angela, I am 53 years of age and I was born on the 1959. When I was 9, I was molested by Father Brian Coffey in the kitchen of my parents home while my mother was cooking tea. He was a priest at our local parish in Port Fairy at the time. He abused me once , but once was enough for me to feel shame for most of my life .

I believe the church's handling or mishandling of the abuse has affected many lives. I feel this kind of abuse has breed paedophilia from generation to generation, and that's what disturbs me.
