INQUIRY INTO THE FIREFIGHTERS' PRESUMPTIVE RIGHTS COMPENSATION AND FIRE SERVICES LEGISLATION AMENDMENT (REFORM) BILL 2017

My name is: Byron Kershaw, I am an Operations Officer with the Country Fire Authority. I have been employed by the CFA for over 33 years and volunteered with my local brigades for 39 years living in Buckley 30 Kilometres West of Geelong on a farm with my family.

My Current working location is District 06 Colac Headquarters as an Operations Officer. I have held this position for 5 years; I look after 34 Volunteer brigades and 3 Groups from Wye River to Cape Otway and North of Lismore.

I am writing this submission in support of the proposed reform of the fire services for the following reasons:

CFA Volunteers will benefit greatly from the xpchange, as management will be able to concentrate on core business with the support of the VFVB, without any industrial issues.

The proposed Fire Rescue Victoria will have one agreement for all career firefighters, no duplication of equipment, uniforms, communications and appliances. A guaranteed response in all FRV areas with an increased safety to public and firefighters.
