On 21st September, 1993, I had a meeting with Mrs. Carmel Giddings, nee Rafferty. You will recall that she was a former teacher at Holy Family Primary School, Doveton, and that she resigned on 24th April, 1993.

She has been unable to obtain employment since. She was accompanied on her visit to me by her brother, Peter Rafferty, who indicated that he was concerned that his sister had been placed under great stress and needed some support in obtaining a reference. Neither wanted to approach Father Seanson for such a reference and wondered if some sort of a reference could be obtained for her. I indicated that I would seek your advice to see what could be done. I am not sure of the relationship that exists between the Principal, [redacted], and Mrs. Giddings and suspect that it is not a happy one.

Is there any way in which a reference could be written for Mrs. Giddings. I am aware that Father [redacted] is fully informed of the situation. Is it possible for [redacted] to oblige in this matter?
