I am a committed Catholic and regularly attended church with my children over the last few years. In or about approximately the Parish Priest of formed my son a job.

Fr said he would pay between, \$5.00-\$8.00 per hour. Was 14 years old when he started working for Fr the work was to take place on Friday afternoons after school and involved typing and filing at the presbytery. At the time I agreed for to assist Fr the in this way and initially had no concerns about it.

After some weeks, however, the hours that Fr **and** required to attend the presbytery appeared to get later and later. After a few Friday nights where Fr **and** had started dropping home at approximately 10-10.30pm, I complained to Fr**ance** that this was simply too late for **and** that I wanted him to be home by 7.30pm. This still allowed him approximately 4 hours from after school time.

For the following two weeks Fr did return home at approximately 7.30pm. However, after that on Friday nights, I would receive phone calls from saying that Fr needed him to do more work and asking if he could stay later. My husband, and I became concerned about home work and that he was becoming very tired with these late Friday nights every week. was also very busy on Saturday afternoons as he had to leave home early to assist Fr to set up the altar for mass at 5.00pm on Saturdays. Again on Saturday would drop home after mass, but not until 9.00pm. nights, Fr was required to altar serve at mass on Sunday mornings also.

My husband and I explained to that we felt that this was too time consuming for him and that he needed to make sure that he got his home work done. When explained our





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concerns to Frances, Frances told that he could use Frances computer at the Presbytery for his home work.

After some time of working for Free the asked me whether he could employ for longer hours if he sacked the Presbytery secretary, I told him 'no', as I was already uncomfortable with what he was discussing with and with the long hours was spending with Free to the sacked the presbytery secretary.



On many occasions I asked France for a Catholic counsellor, however he kept on delaying organising this for me, saying that he wanted to be involved, that he could drive us to counselling and that he would sit in on our counselling. This eventually turned into him actually being the counsellor for us. However, he never organised any counselling but would always be discouraging whenever I raised the issue of wanting to see a Catholic counsellor.

when things were getting very difficult for us at home, I went to see Fr with a list of Counsellors and asked for guidance of which Counsellor would be best for He discouraged me from going to any of them stating it would be best for him to help

relationship with He became supportive of us reconciling and he told me that he would offer a bed if necessary, he also offered to pay my mortgage however, I said no.

I soon became aware that Free was texting everyday and would often lure him to come to the Presbytery after school before he went home.



Frequent after would turn up at my home at all hours of the night and this became significantly more frequent after would had left. He would say that he was coming to help me with my finances but while he was at my home, he would not do anything on my finances but would bring DVD's would and would spend all the time focusing on

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If I confronted him about this and tried to get him to leave, he would argue with me in front of the children. I often made the decision to back down as I did not want to expose the children to any further arguments between adults,

later told me that Free had asked him to lie to us many times about staying longer at the Presbytery to work with Fr

After I became aware that Fr was constantly contacting and and not respecting the boundaries I was trying to set, I insisted that took calls from him while in the same room as me. The received phone calls and texts all hours of the day, mornings, school time as well as evenings on his way home from school. I have a written note made by Fr bus bus and school schedule so he knew when he could get in contact with him.

I confronted Free many times about my concerns. Always he would respond by saying that needed him, and needed to spend time with him and needed to be counselled by him. He told me to back off and let him do his job. Because he was my parish priest, even though I felt very uncomfortable with his behaviour, I did not want to cause further conflict and I let the matter drop. I felt completely disempowered by him.

On one occasion, Francesco took and out of school without my permission. The told me that the contacted him telling him not to catch the bus home as he would pick him up and take him home, but instead he took to be back to his place keeping him there. This was done without consulting or informing me so I started to panic when the was not home by 5pm. I rang mobile a few times with no answer and the phone too. Eventually I rang mobile again and he answered and told me he was at the but was now on his way home.

After some weeks of my growing concerns about Free behaviour toward to , I spoke to my friend set to She immediately warned me that this situation was an unhealthy one and to get the away from Free as soon as possible. At the time I spoke with her, I also read her a number of text messages from Free to which I had saved. Agreed to help me to disengage Free from my family.

This was a very difficult thing for me to do as would often run up to Fr as he always had lollies and treats for them. Also, whenever we went to Mass he would not want me to take would home straight afterwards, but would try to manipulate the situation. For example, offering the children takeaways and DVD's in their presence to prolong contact with my family.

By I was experiencing enonnous stress due to trying to deal with Fr behaviour toward I was also under pressure due to my husband's absence from the family home. Fr suggested he take myself, and seven away for a week's retreat, where we would have a week of counselling and daily Mass. I was unsure about his



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suggestion, but in the end I agreed to go because he said he would say Mass daily and I was hopeful that the counselling would assist us all.

As it transpired, Mass was only said once during that week and I had only a five minute counselling session with Free I confronted him about the lack of counselling and Mass, and Free I told me: "I'm having fun I don't want to work; the kids are enjoying it, leave it."

It was during the week away that I became even more concerned about Free behaviour toward

I observed Fr playing "footsy" with that is, using his feet to poke body. Secondly, during a game of tennis Fr behaved as if he had pulled a hamstring and went down on the ground. I strongly suspect he did not pull a hamstring, however, he asked to massage his leg for him and when behaved at him to go higher up his leg, telling him he was not in the right spot. The massaging happened at the retreat in the lounge room. I saw what took place even though I was in the kitchen at the time behaved did not massage his leg higher up.

On another occasion, Fr **and asked were** to get his keys out of his front pocket. He was wearing tracksuit pants at the time and his hands were full and he insisted that **and a put his** hand inside his pocket to get the keys. I felt that all of these instances were most inappropriate and it made me very concerned about what Fr **and a problem** to do when I was not present. By the end of the retreat week I was beside myself and spoke with my family. I told them of Fr **and a problem** behaviour over the recent months by toward

My family and I made the decision to take and have the rest of the year off, finish off assignments and post them in from my parents' with the possibility that the teachers could send work that needed to be completed by correspondence. I wanted to take on once and for all adult to adult, rather than have a child confront an adult, and to stop him from abusing my son and make answerable for his behaviour.


After told Front that he was going to stay Fr confronted me and told me that he could no longer protect me from Child Protection Services. He put enormous pressure on both me and to to change our minds. He said things to me and total ike 'total is running away from his problems, he should stay and face them", If he leaves he will be a quitter for life", He will have difficulty passing his VCE if he goes now", "I need him, I will miss him, I will go on sick leave until total gets back", "If I was his teacher I would fail him to teach him a lesson."

I felt I had no other option but to send my son away as I constant intrusions.

The following Sunday at Mass Free told the congregation that he was suffering from Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, was not sleeping and was having a rough time. He broke down crying, said he was not coping and asked for everybody to pray for him and support him. After he walked out of Mass, he was surrounded by concerned parishioners who assured him of their support.



I felt extremely angry with this behaviour and had to calm my children down as they did not understand why Frank was crying. I felt it highly unfair that he was seeking support from all the parishioners, when in fact it was us who were suffering because of his behaviour.

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Following this behaviour at Sunday Mass, and rang me to enquire where was as he did not see him at Mass. I told was at a friend's place as I did not want him to know Seconds later he sent a text to mobile, which I had, saying "him I am still struglin I will b back tues please keep in contact daily if possible I need ur support I was furious when I saw this text and again went to my friend and told her about it.

After that, I went to the Principal away from my children. I explained my grave concerns about Fr and that I desperately needed help to get Fr to back off from my family. was very supportive and told me to leave the matter with him and that he would advise his contacts of my situation. He then gave me Mr Peter O'Callaghan's phone number.

I immediately rang Mr O'Callaghan's phone number and was told by him that he was in hospital waiting for a bypass. I begged him for some support and he apologised that he was the only person available to assist, but given that he was in hospital, he could not do anything at that time.

Since I made the report to Mr O'Callaghan, has made disclosures to me about Fr stroking his head, massaging him and the occasion when he tried to pull his pants down. in which Fr has also since told me of a phone call from Fr told he was said to him: "I am a being tempted by the devil to masturbate. He has also told me that better role model than your Dad". said to me: "You should sell up and move to with me, either that or I give up the priesthood and move in with you guys. I love to bits." When I went to see in his office and to enquire as to the type of work that was doing for him I noticed that all the windows were covered by bookcases which completely blocked out any natural light and the lights were turned on. I enquired why he had covered all the windows and replied that he liked his privacy when he worked. He didn't want people to be able to look in through the windows.



I am extremely disappointed in the Catholic Church and in priests.

I have also felt frustrated and disappointed by the response of the Melbourne Catholic Archdiocese. Although I begged for help from Mr Peter O'Callaghan, there was some delay in a response to me and I had to deal with Free Contacting me directly and asking me for help.

Although I was told that From was given 24 hours to get out of the second and not to have any contact with me or my children pending an investigation, I am aware that From has had many discussions with other parishioners and has spread rumours about me, for example, saying that I was having an affair with him and that my family had become too dependent on him.



I am anxious for other parents and their children to be made aware of the risks that can be posed by priests such as Free contents. I do not want Free contents to hurt any other families or children.
