## The Catholic Church 2012:

- The Catholic Church appears to have made many positive changes since my dealings with them in 1997 in relation to clergy abuse.
- In 1997, all that was available was a double-sided brochure outlining "Towards Healing" program and a contact number.
- In 2012, the changes include clear guidelines and process for all aspects of dealing
  with victims of clergy abuse. Their website and in particular their pages on the
  Towards Healing initiative provide comprehensive information and support for those
  seeking justice and compensation for clergy abuse.
- June 2012 I contacted Carelink, a Catholic support agency to try and get a copy of
  the statement I had given to the Church back in 1997. I contacted Carelink first
  rather than the Towards Healing number as I thought as a counselling service I am
  more likely strike someone with some compassion.
- I was treated extremely well and a search was conducted for my statement. I was
  also encouraged to recontact Towards Healing to speak to Mr Peter O'Callaghan QC
  again. I was offered assistance with transport and a support person to accompany
  me to see Mr O'Callaghan when I recounted my experience of hesitation and fear
  back in 1997.
