Integrity and Oversight Committee

Integrity agencies to appear before Committee

The Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission, Integrity Oversight Victoria and the Victorian Ombudsman will appear at a public hearing on Monday March 2 as part of the Integrity and Oversight Committee’s annual review of the performance of the Victorian integrity agencies.

The Committee earlier heard from the Office of the Victorian Information Commissioner and the Parliamentary Workplace Standards and Intergrity Commission.

“This public hearing provides an important forum for the Committee to question the heads of the Victorian integrity agencies on how they have carried out their functions over the 2023/24 and 2024/25 period,” said the Committee’s Chair, Dr Tim Read.

The public hearings will be broadcast on the Victorian Parliament’s website from 1:30 pm.
