You can see by my D.O.B. that i will be Turning 8x years of age in less than 2 months, I have Two wonderful children and four also wonderful grandchildren and I see them all regularly.

/ live alone and core for myself. I drive and shop and have an orasional lunch or dinner with close friends , also manage to carry out household chores. although ; was divorced in 1995 i remained close to my ex-wife who passed away in 2009. My health is deteriating faster than i would like and i may not be able to care for myself bayond The end of this year, or sooner. Based on my personal experience going into an Ageof Care facility is definately not an option. Surgery and rehab to misrove my mobility is also not an option, my choice. I must add that surgery etc., to hopefully improve my mobility has been very carefully considered. If nature clossit intervene in ending my life before I lose my independance and dignity / have only one choice that / will ensure will appear to be a natural event. All things considered I have had a good life and I am not afraid to end it on my Torms. I have an excelent G.P and many close trienals and tamily and i believe I am off sound mind. In conclusion , ask The committee to carefully consider the following: -

1. I believe it is proven common knowledge that in excess of 75% to 80% of the population believe it is the right of the individual to die with dignity, Their choice.

- 2. From personal experience know that many people are committed into living in aged care against Their will, either by medical assessment or tamily pressure.
- 3: Also from personal experience I know That many people living in aged care live in abject misery and it they had the choice would prefer to end their life.
- 4. Medically assisted dying approved by legislation is the only answer to a long over due and very important need.
