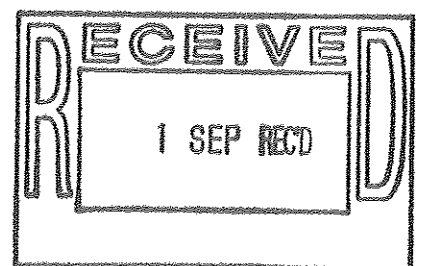

End of life choices. I wish to submit my thoughts relating to "end of life choices"

Recently my wife and I experienced the death of Reg Boyd when we had been in constant touch with Reg over the six months, up to his passing.

My belief on "Dying with Dignity" is simply that a legally constituted panel should be available to decide whether any person should have the legal right to stop living. This panel should comprise selected individuals to make this decision.

The next of kin and the patient would meet with the panel to present their case.

Most importantly such a procedure would negate the requirement of family members being responsible for ending a life!

Currently I am not satisfied with the termination of death process. I believe that so many deaths occur, with justification, but with illegality.
