Dear Your Excellency Barton - MP,

My wife and I would like to submit our dissatisfaction and desperation with the Victoria Government to the change of CPV policy.

Like most of the families, we plan ahead of our retirement by keeping a taxi license, so that we hope to receive some regular cash income from the license rental without relying too much from the Government. As such, we borrowed some money from our relatives to finance us purchasing a taxi license and reimburse them by working very hard for a long period of time. While almost to the maturity of our repayment, the Government had changed the policy of withdrawing the license from us by compensating AUD100,000 to us which is far below than our purchasing price. For our long term loss, apart from losing the steady income regularly, we also lost significantly to the license purchased price against the Government's compensation. Since our income has been reduced, our retirement life becomes harder and our family's harmony has been deteriorated which always instigated by money problem.

My wife and I support you to fight for us and obtain a reasonable long term compensation from the Government either in cash form or reissue a new license to us.
