**Performance of Victorian integrity agencies: public hearings**

On Monday 9 May 2022, the Victorian Parliament's Integrity and Oversight Committee will hold public hearings with the Victorian Inspectorate, the Office of the Victorian Information Commissioner and the Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission.

The hearings will examine the integrity agencies' performance with a focus on their management of the welfare of witnesses and others involved in agency investigations.

'As an exercise of the Committee's broad function to review and monitor the performance of Victoria's integrity agencies, public hearings give these agencies an opportunity to present on their work including as it may relate to challenges or opportunities for improvement', said Committee Chair Harriet Shing MP.

'These public hearings enable the Committee to scrutinise agencies' performance, which is itself vital to proper oversight and accountability', Ms Shing explained.

**2:30 PM: Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission**
