Answer:

Breakthrough Victoria is working with World View's major investor to ensure the company continues to grow its presence in Victoria.

To end June 2025, World View had 3 employees in Victoria supporting its establishment-related activities. Breakthrough Victoria retains its confidence in World View's position in the sensing landscape, and the benefits to Australia of a presence in this technology field.

World View has groundbreaking technology in the global market for remote sensing technologies that is expected to grow to US\$22.8 billion by 2027.

World View is currently transitioning its Melbourne base from Carlton to South Melbourne which includes an initial site for manufacturing.

Answer:

At the end of June 2025, over 2,000 new direct jobs were projected to be created from Breakthrough Victoria's investments.
