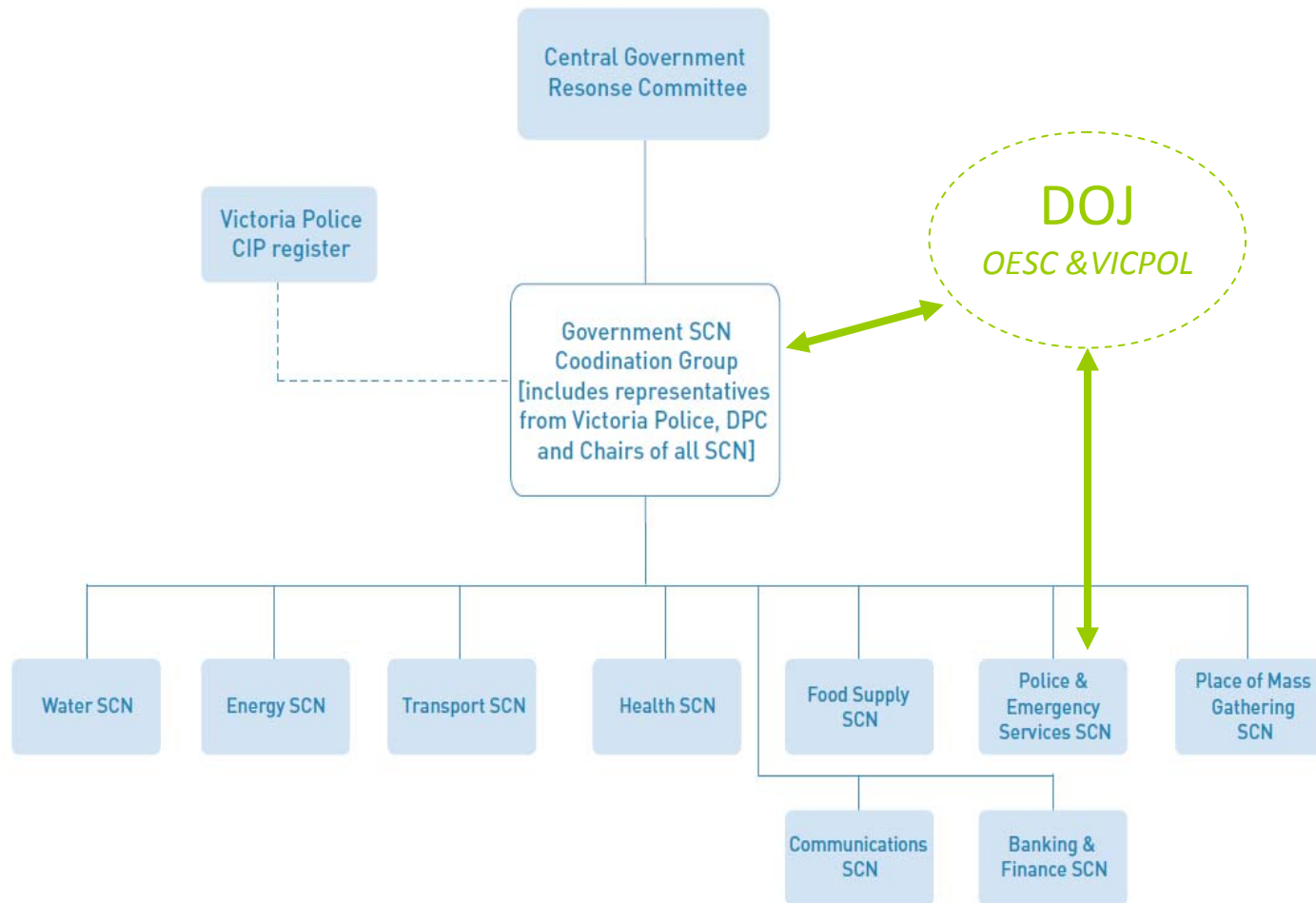

CIP Framework – Security and Continuity Networks (SCNs)





DOJ Responsibilities – Police and Emergency Services SCN

Under the Framework, OESC has responsibility to:

1. work with emergency service organisation's (ESOs) to ensure they have protective arrangements in place to protect associated key facilities
2. work with ESOs to develop relevant capabilities for CIP and ensure continuity of service
3. communicate relevant non-time critical intelligence and CIP information to stakeholders
4. provide emergency management and business continuity advice across the sector as required
5. co-chair (with police) the Police and Emergency Services SCN.

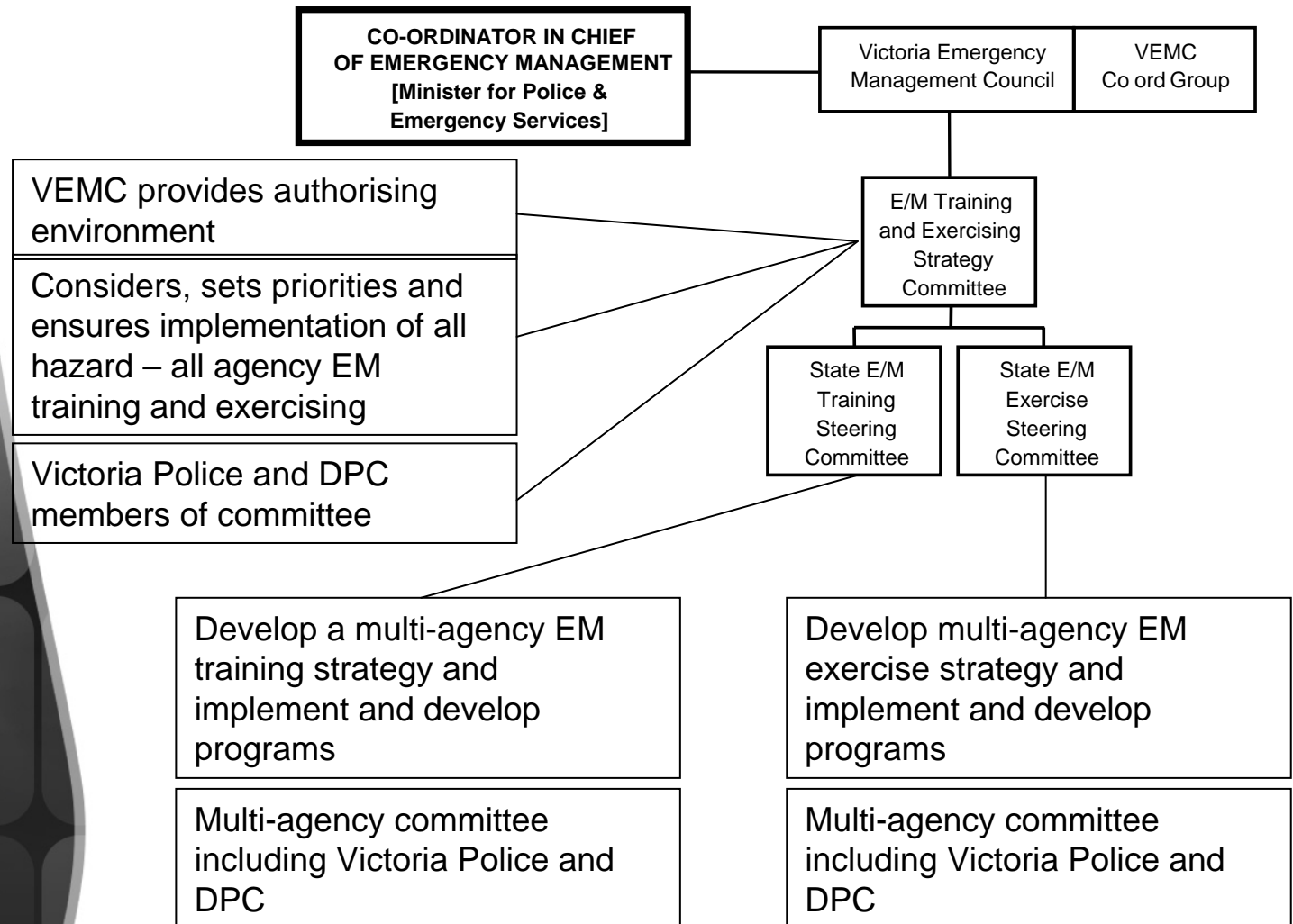

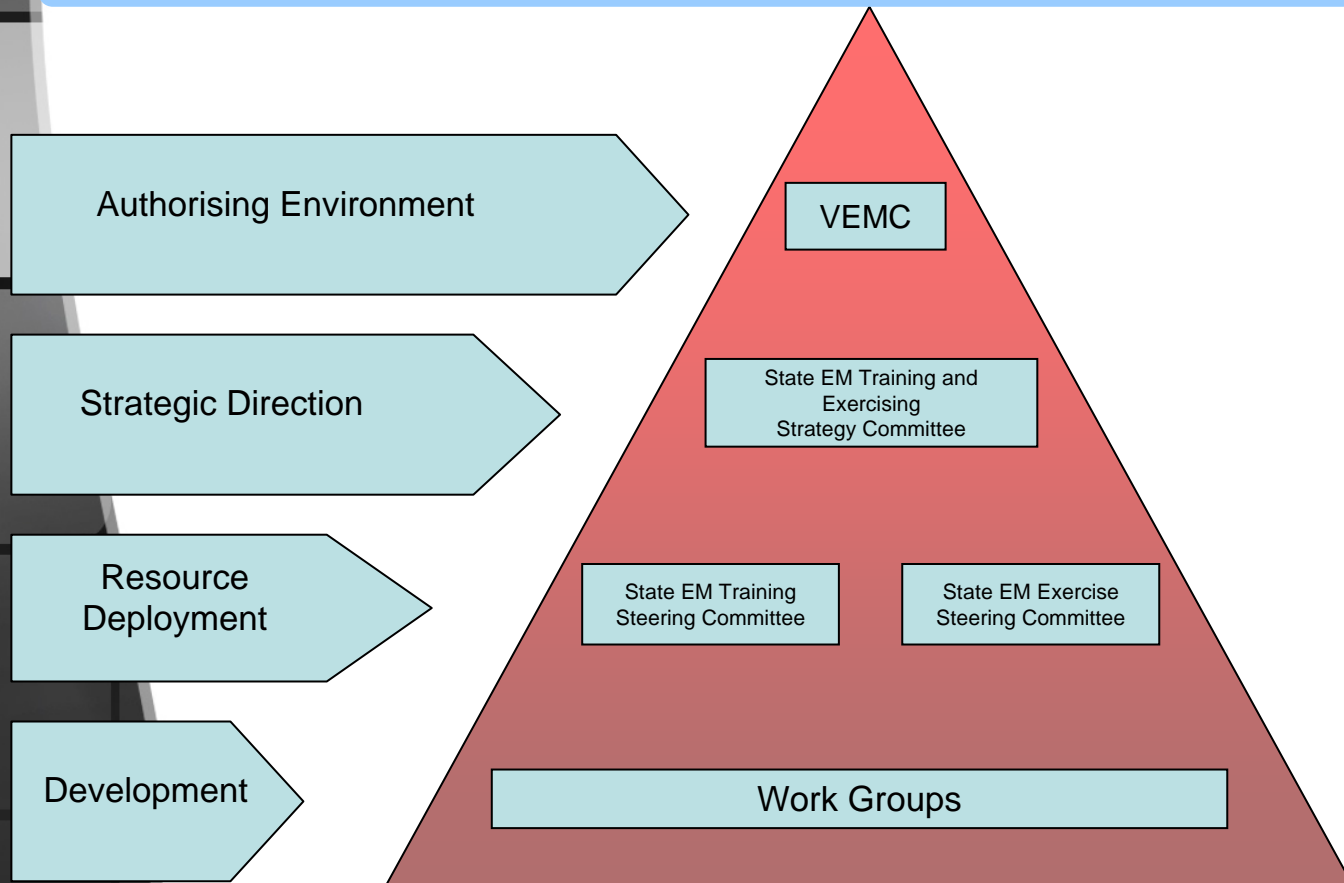
