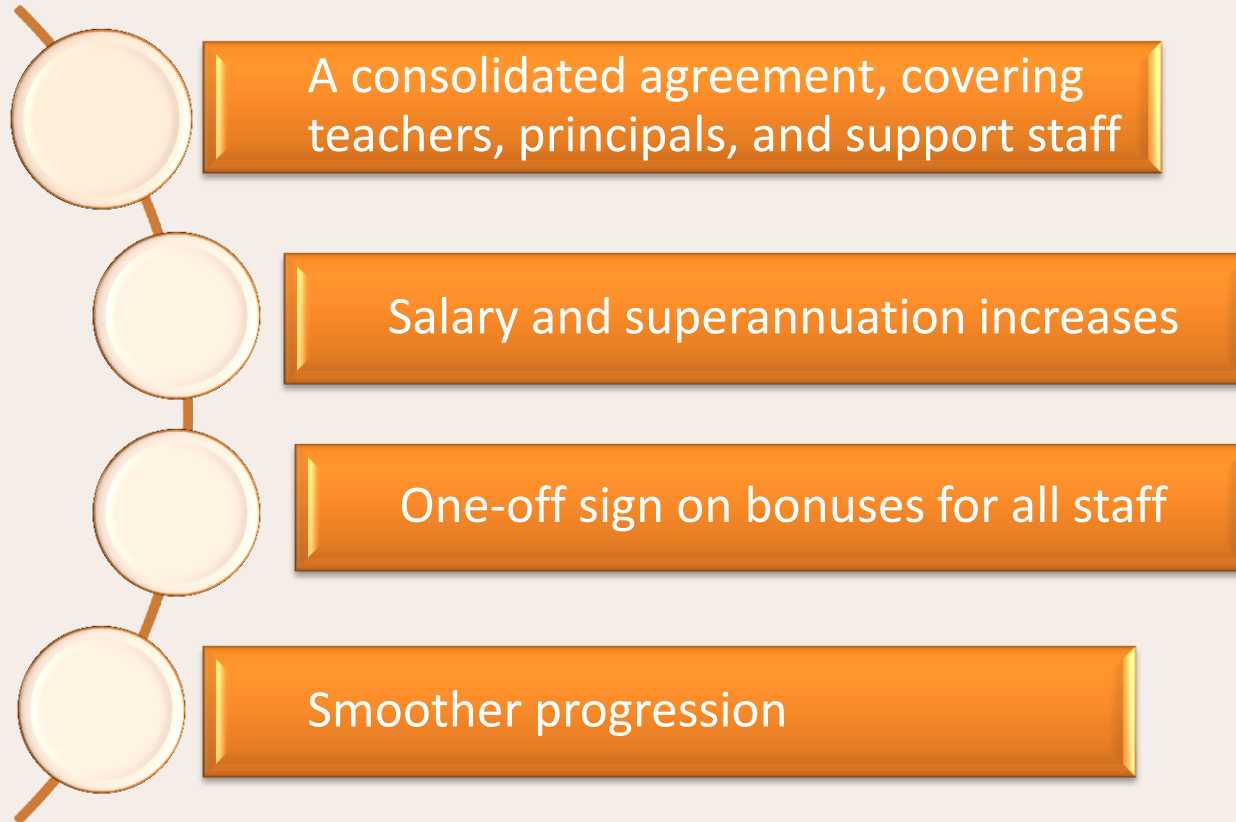

\$15.7 million is being invested in the 2013-14 Budget to lift school performance via principal and teacher professional development and targeted programs.



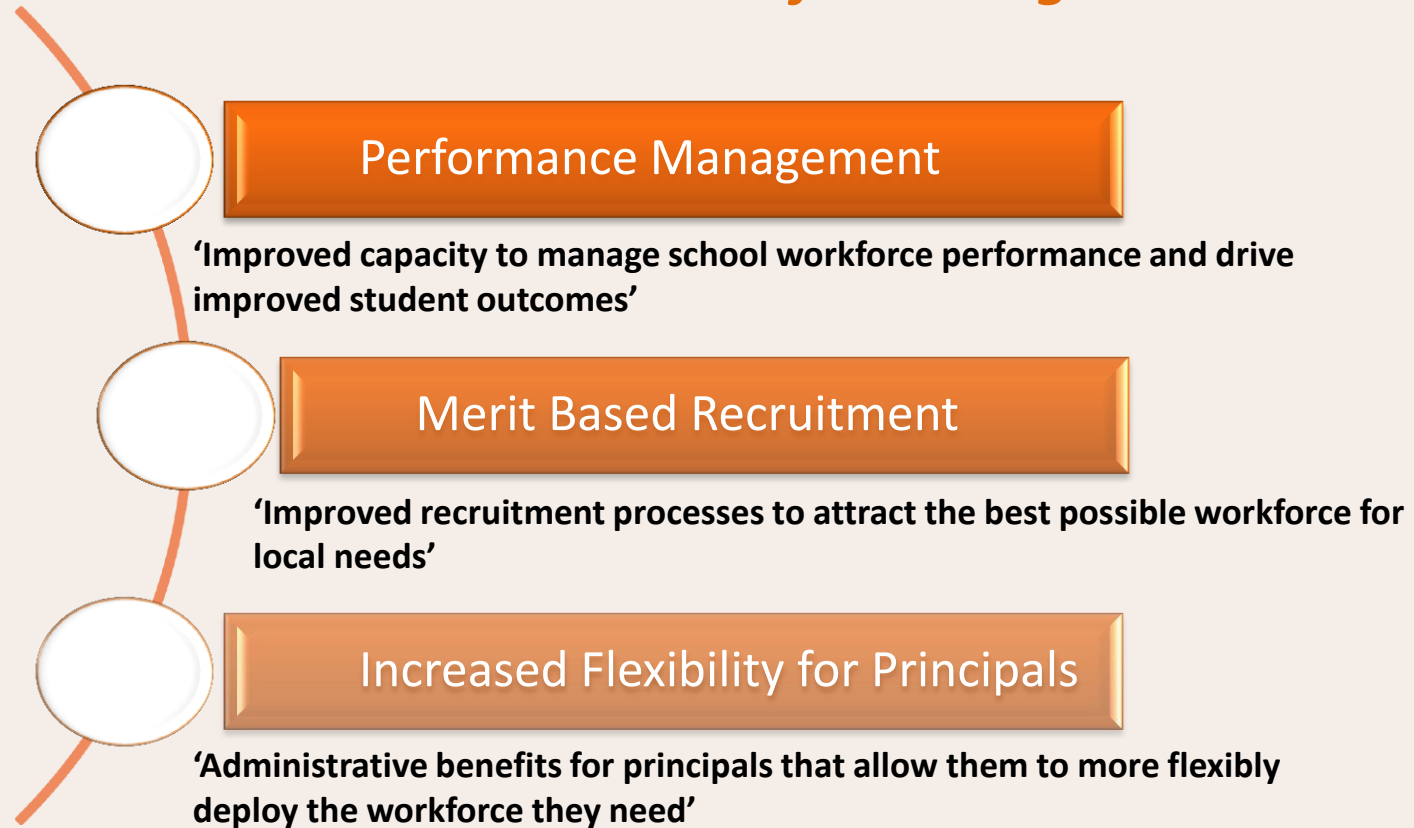
