Peri Urban Councils at next hearing on rate capping

Next Wednesday 22 August, the Environment and Planning Committee will hold a public hearing on its ongoing inquiry into the Victorian Government's rate capping policy.

The public hearing will be held from 7:00 pm in the Legislative Council Committee Room at Parliament House.

Representatives from the Peri Urban Group of Rural Councils will be presenting to the Committee. The group covers the following councils: Bass Coast, Baw Baw, Golden Plains, Macedon Ranges, Moorabool, Murrindindi and Surf Coast.

The inquiry is examining the outcome of the Victorian Government's rate capping policy on councils' viability, service impacts on local communities and impacts on the provision of local infrastructure.
