Thank you for the opportunity to respond to this question, that was taken on notice. I wish to confirm that the correction for figure that the Strengthening Hospital Responses to Family Violence initiative was funded for over the 5 year period post the Victorian Royal Commission into Family Violence was \$38.4 million, according to funding letters received by the 27 sites that received direct funding from the Victorian Government. The peak of funding was in 2018-19 financial year, and funding was reduced over the next two financial years. At the time, we had been advised that the funding allocations for the lead and standalone sites was allocated based on staff EFT for their health service or cluster. We/I were not privy to the precise figures provided to each of the sites that received funding during this time period, and the distribution of funds to their relevant cluster sites was at the discretion of the site receiving the funding.

I hope this clarifies my response.
