Dear Ms Purdey,

Please find following a response to the Items on Notice from the 5 December session of the Legal and Social Issues Committee's Inquiry into the Public Housing Renewal Program.

Council is still awaiting the release of data from the 2016 Australian Government Census in relation to homelessness and thus figures from 2011 have been supplied.

The number of homeless persons recorded in Bayside in 2011 was 214.

Information in relation to social housing is more recent, with records indicating that in 2016 there were 931 dwellings in Bayside that were being rented from a government authority.

This represents around 2.5% of all households in the City of Bayside and is generally in line with the figure for Greater Melbourne which is 2.6% of all households are renting their dwelling from a government authority.
