Hearings and forum in Sale on invasive animals

Public hearings and a public forum will be held in Sale on Thursday 6 and Friday 7 October for the parliamentary inquiry into the control of invasive animals on Crown land.

The hearings and forum will be held at the Gippsland Regional Sports Complex, 116 Cobains Rd, Sale.

On Thursday 6 October public hearings will take place from 12 noon to 5:00 pm and will be followed by an open forum from 5:00 pm that will provide community members with the opportunity to share their views and experiences with the Environment, Natural Resources and Regional Development Committee.

“The open forum will allow any member of the community to have their say,” said Ms Bronwyn Halfpenny MP, Chair of the Committee. “We are keen to hear from people about what is working and what isn’t in their local areas, and what more can be done to tackle the problems of invasive animals.”

On Friday 7 October public hearings will be held from 9:30 am to 1:15 pm.
