



# Investing in more freight on rail

- \$181 million package of upgrades to the regional rail network
- 12-month extension of the Mode Shift Incentive Scheme, which provides incentives to move over 42,000 export containers from regional Victoria by rail and removes 28,000 truck trips off country roads every year

# Key outcomes of port reform

- Establishment of Ports Victoria
- 63 recommendations to improve the ports system
- Giving Ports Victoria a role in overseeing the performance of the state's harbour masters
- Giving harbour masters clear responsibility and powers to ensure navigational safety in their ports
