Election conduct hearing focuses on inclusion

Representatives of Inclusion Melbourne, a service provider for adults with intellectual disability, and others will present to the Electoral Matters Committee at a public hearing next week on the conduct of the 2022 Victorian state election.

The public hearing will be held on Monday 27 November commencing at 2:00 pm and will be live streamed on the Committee's <u>website</u>, where submissions and transcripts of earlier hearings can also be found.

The inquiry is examining a host of key issues from enrolment to candidature, campaigning behaviour and the voting process, as well as the role and functions of the Victorian Electoral Commission.

It will also examine options for reforms, including changes to the Upper House voting system and improvements to the voter experience.

The Committee will report in mid-2024.
