Voting centre worker to appear before election review

The Electoral Matters Committee will hear from an election worker in a hearing to be held on Monday.

The Committee is reviewing the conduct of the 2022 state election.

Ron Townsend worked at a voting centre during the election. He will share his experience and suggestions for future improvements in a hearing from 2 pm on Monday October 2.

The inquiry is examining a host of key issues from enrolment, to candidature, campaigning behaviour and the voting process, as well as the role and functions of the VEC.
