

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### 2017-18 Budget Initiatives

- Court Integrated Services Program and Remand Outreach Program
  - \$25.2 million over 4 years
- Legal aid funding
  - \$79.6 million over 4 years
- Supporting community legal centres
  - \$24.7 million over 4 years
- Supporting victims of crime
  - \$28.5 million over 4 years
- Courts case management system
  - \$89.2 million over 4 years



#### 2017-18 Budget Initiatives

- Specialist family violence integrated court response
  - \$130.3 million over 4 years
- Supreme Court of Victoria IT upgrade
  - \$10.9 million over 4 years
- Safe and sustainable Victorian courts
  - \$12.4 million over 4 years
- Fast Track Remand Court
  - \$3.4 million over 2 years
- Family Drug Treatment Court
  - \$1.4 million over 1 year



## 2017-18 Budget Initiatives

- Forensic mental health implementation plan
  - \$35.7 million over 4 years
- Bendigo and Werribee law courts Planning
  - \$7.6 million over 1 year
- Support for Aboriginal Victorians at risk of family violence
  - \$23.6 million over 4 years
- Diversion for Aboriginal male perpetrators of family violence
  - \$3.2 million over 4 years
