ESTABLISHING THE EDUCATION STATE

Through unprecedented investment, our last two state budgets provided:

- Over \$4 billion investment in our schools, including significant investment in school infrastructure
- Funded our election commitments with implementation underway
- \$1.4 billion to establish the Education state
 - This included \$566 million in increased equity funding
- Funded our share of the Gonski
 Agreement for 2015, 2016 and 2017







EQUITY FUNDING IN SCHOOLS

We have provided **\$566 million** over four years in additional equity funding to schools based on the levels of disadvantage at their school.

This comprised:

- \$493 million to support schools with students who face more barriers to success than their peers.
- \$72.3 million to target students who have not met the national NAPLAN standard.

Schools are using equity funding for a range of initiatives, including:

- Additional staffing to support targeted programs
- Intervention programs to support improved literacy and numeracy, or wellbeing
- Time release to allow teachers to participate in professional development such as professional learning communities





EQUITY FUNDING IN SCHOOLS

Case Study – Dallas Brooks Community Primary School

- \$1.6 million in equity funding for 2017
- Two English as an Additional Language language classrooms for students
- Full time social worker
- Employing maths consultant, literacy and numeracy coaches to significantly boost teaching expertise and student outcomes at all levels.
- Employing a play therapist to work with children who have experienced trauma





2017-18 BUDGET

The 2017-18 Budget builds on these investments by providing \$1.1 billion for the education portfolio:

\$675 million for new schools, upgrades and new buildings

\$457 million in output funding to support our students, teachers,

principals and support staff







SCHOOLS EBA

On top of our investments in the 2017-18 Budget, the recently negotiated **\$2.3 billion** EBA puts teachers at the forefront of our school improvement agenda.

The EBA includes:

- 3000 new learning specialist positions created
- 2500 teachers and 5000 support staff will move from contract employment to ongoing employment
- 4% pay increase for Principals per year
- 3.25% pay increase for teachers and education support staff annually







INFRASTRUCTURE

We know a great education starts with a great school







BUILDING THE EDUCATION STATE

- A funding boost of \$675 million in this year's Budget for:
 - new schools
 - scores of schools getting upgrades and new buildings

This includes **\$265.1 million** to plan and acquire land and build new schools, many in growth areas

\$85 million to progress the Government's commitment to removing asbestos from all government schools







BUILDING THE EDUCATION STATE

- \$195.2 million to upgrade and modernise 108 schools across the state
 - **59** regional and rural schools
 - 49 metropolitan schools
- \$44.4 million to upgrade six special schools
- \$75 million for new relocatable buildings to meet immediate enrolment demand







BUILDING THE EDUCATION STATE

This huge investment in our schools and kids brings the Government's investment in school infrastructure to **\$2.5 billion** in only three budgets

The Government is rolling out **56** new schools across the state



SUPPORTING OUR STUDENTS

The Victorian Budget invests \$457 million in school funding.

This includes:

- \$90 million in Education State funding
- \$67.9 million in Critical IT and an extra \$16.4 million to increase bandwidth and digital connectivity for rural schools.
- \$9.2 million for Swimming in Schools as part of the Victorian Curriculum
- \$7.8 million to extend the successful Navigator student reengagement pilot to approximately 1700 students
- \$5.7 million more for schools to better enable them to accept late student enrolments
- \$1.7 million to extend Student Mentoring to an additional 800 students





SUPPORTING OUR STUDENTS

We are also funding:

- \$58.4 million to meet demand for the Program for Students with Disabilities in 2018
- \$21.2 million for student transport to meet increased demand for specialist school students and expand the number of students eligible for the Conveyance Allowance Program
- \$19.5 million to boost teaching of English as an Additional Language







TEACHERS, PRINCIPALS AND SUPPORT STAFF

We recognise that our educators make a real difference in our classrooms and in the lives of our children







SUPPORTING OUR TEACHERS

\$50.7 million over five years to support more than **300** of Victoria's schools to adopt proven practices aimed at dramatically improving student outcomes:

- Turnaround Teams consisting of an executive principal and two leading teachers
- Highly capable Executive Principals
- School Improvement Partnerships to connect leadership teams from 64 underperforming schools with those from high-performing schools
- Up to 25 of Victoria's best teachers to join Specialist Teaching Teams and be deployed to build the capabilities of classroom teachers in up to 50 schools each year.





SUPPORTING OUR TEACHERS

This Budget includes **\$9.7 million** for the landmark **Excellence in Teacher Education reforms**:


- to create high-quality, alternative pathways into teaching
- \$4.6 million to improve induction for up to 10,000 graduate teachers
- \$3.1 million to train about 250 high-achieving candidates to work in hard-to-staff schools

We will also invest **\$24 million** over **four** years to lift the quality of teaching and school leadership, which includes **\$18.3 million** to expand the Professional Learning Communities initiative to up to **200** schools
