




Investing in Ambulance Services

- Total funding for ambulance services is budgeted at \$1.028 billion in 2017-18.
- This includes the \$500 million package announced in December 2016 which is already being rolled out.
- It also includes \$26.5 million in 2017-18 Budget funding to meet growth in demand.
- Real progress is being made on implementing Victoria's ambulance action plan.



Improving ambulance response times



- Statewide ambulance response times are at their **best level in five years**.
- Code 1, 15-minute response times
 have risen above 80 per cent for the
 first time since the previous State
 Labor Government.
- Clinical outcomes are improving –with survival from out-of-hospital cardiac arrest rising by 2 per cent on the previous year to a record 31 per cent.
- Our \$500 million package will recruit
 450 additional paramedics, build new branches and improve response times further.

Investing in our ambulance workforce



- During this year, 372 new paramedic graduates have been recruited.
- This is in addition to the 180
 paramedics hired this year as part of our \$500 million package.
- We are rolling out improved health and safety support and training.
- Partnering with Beyondblue to improve paramedics' mental health.
- Public awareness campaign to combat occupational violence to roll out.
- New stretchers have been rolled out across the fleet to improve OH&S.
