REGIONAL VICTORIA – VITAL TO OUR ECONOMIC STRENGTH AND WAY OF LIFE

- \$71.6 billion annual economy
- Home to one in four Victorians
- Some 700,000 workers
- A third of Victoria's \$36 billion export trade
- Some 30% of State's small businesses
- Growing at a faster rate than any other regional area in Australia
- Contributes \$11.5 billion and 114,400 jobs annually through **regional tourism** (one out of six total regional jobs).

We are creating a **stronger regional Victoria** through **job creation, better infrastructure** and **new investment**





GOVHUBS BOOSTING JOBS IN REGIONAL VICTORIA

Regional GovHubs are revitalizing regional cities, improving delivery of existing government services and creating local jobs

Ballarat GovHub

- Home to 1000 government employees across a number of departments and agencies
- Revitalise the Ballarat CBD with redevelopment of the Civic Hall site
- Creating up to 500 construction jobs
- Latrobe GovHub
 - New government office for 150 public service jobs
 - Delivering a \$15 million boost for the local economy and creating up to 170 construction jobs
- Bendigo GovHub
 - Combining several public sector agencies into a single site

REGIONAL PARTNERSHIPS – LISTENING TO LOCAL COMMUNITIES

- **\$29 million** to meet **priorities identified by Regional Partnerships,** including projects in health, education, transport, housing and digital connectivity
- **\$45 million for the Connecting Regional Communities Program** to deliver better digital infrastructure:
 - \$11 million for Mobile Black Spots Program
 - \$12 million to help farmers in north-west Victoria, the Macalister Irrigation District, the Murray-Darling Basin and the Serpentine region adopt internet-enabled on-farm technologies
 - \$7 million for enhanced broadband projects in Morwell, North Geelong, and Horsham
 - \$7 million for digital initiatives to support increased competitiveness of regional industries
 - \$7 million for free public Wi-Fi in Shepparton and Geelong
 - \$1 million to **improve regional services** through access to government communications infrastructure

DRIVING JOBS, NEW INVESTMENT AND INFRASTRUCTURE ACROSS REGIONAL VICTORIA.

- \$500m Regional Jobs and Infrastructure Fund
 - Attracting \$1.17 billion in investment
 - 322 projects approved and 328 projects in pipeline
 - Supporting all Victorian regional Local Government Areas
 - Generating \$123 million in exports
 - To-date, 4600 jobs created and retained
 - Every \$1 of State project investment driving additional \$4.23 investment



SUPPORTING VULNERABLE COMMUNITIES

- Supporting communities recovering from emergencies
 - Wye River–Jamieson Track bushfire recovery
 - Drought Support Fund
 - Mildura storm response



- Supporting communities affected by company closures or downsizing
 - outplacement and transition support to workers in Stawell impacted local business closure
 - support for creation of new industrial land estate in Hamilton
 - **\$500,000** in **2017-18 State Budget** to upskill people in the **Glenelg region** to support the growth of key sectors in the region
