Response

The Minister for Aboriginal Affairs: I am informed that:

LANs (Local Aboriginal Networks) are inclusive of all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders living in Victoria and border towns between Victoria and New South Wales.

Participation in the Koorie Youth Council, is open to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander young people between 12 and 25 years old.
