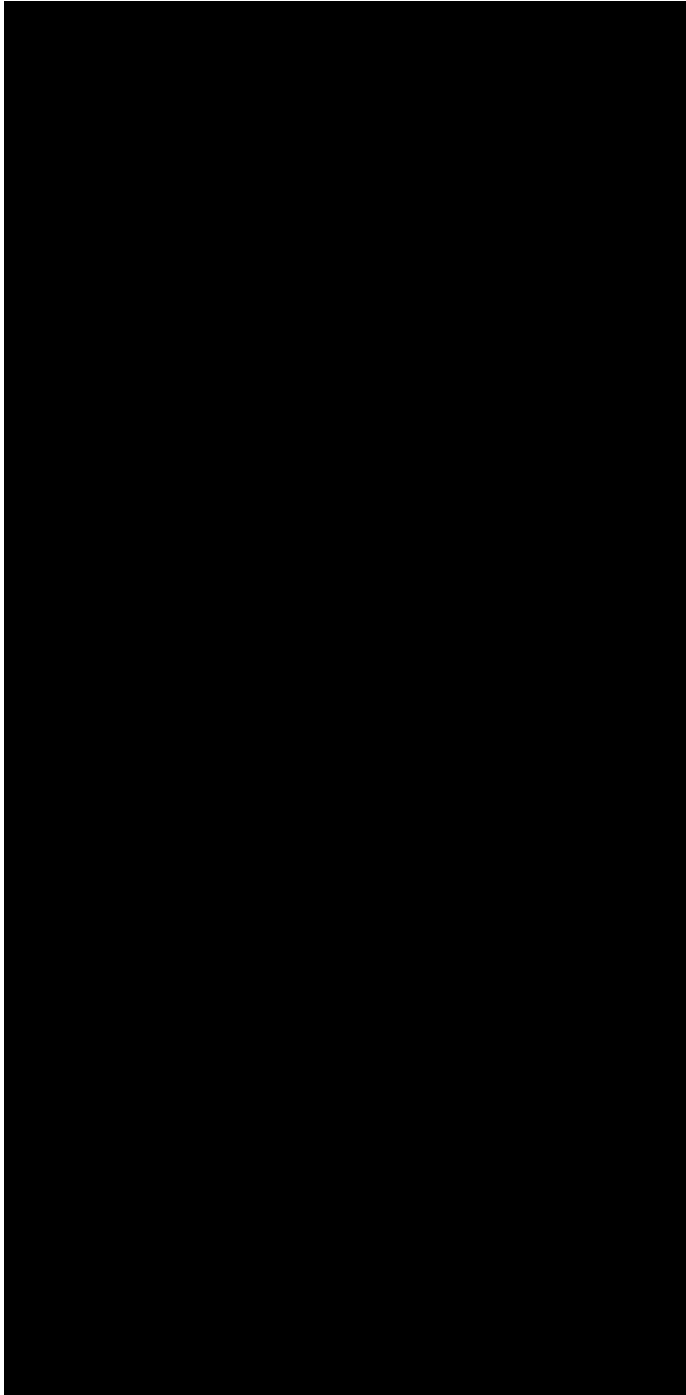


Submission about the proposed incinerator in Wollert
