Registration Rebate: Cost savings for Victorians

- *2026/27 Victorian Budget* delivers a 20% rebate on light vehicle registrations:
 - Light vehicle registration currently costs up to \$930.70 every year, for every car
 - With 20% off, a driver could receive up to \$186, or up to \$372 with two cars
 - From 1 June, eligible vehicle owners can apply for 20% off rego through Service Victoria
 - Applications will be open until 31 July – giving Victorians two months to claim the rebate

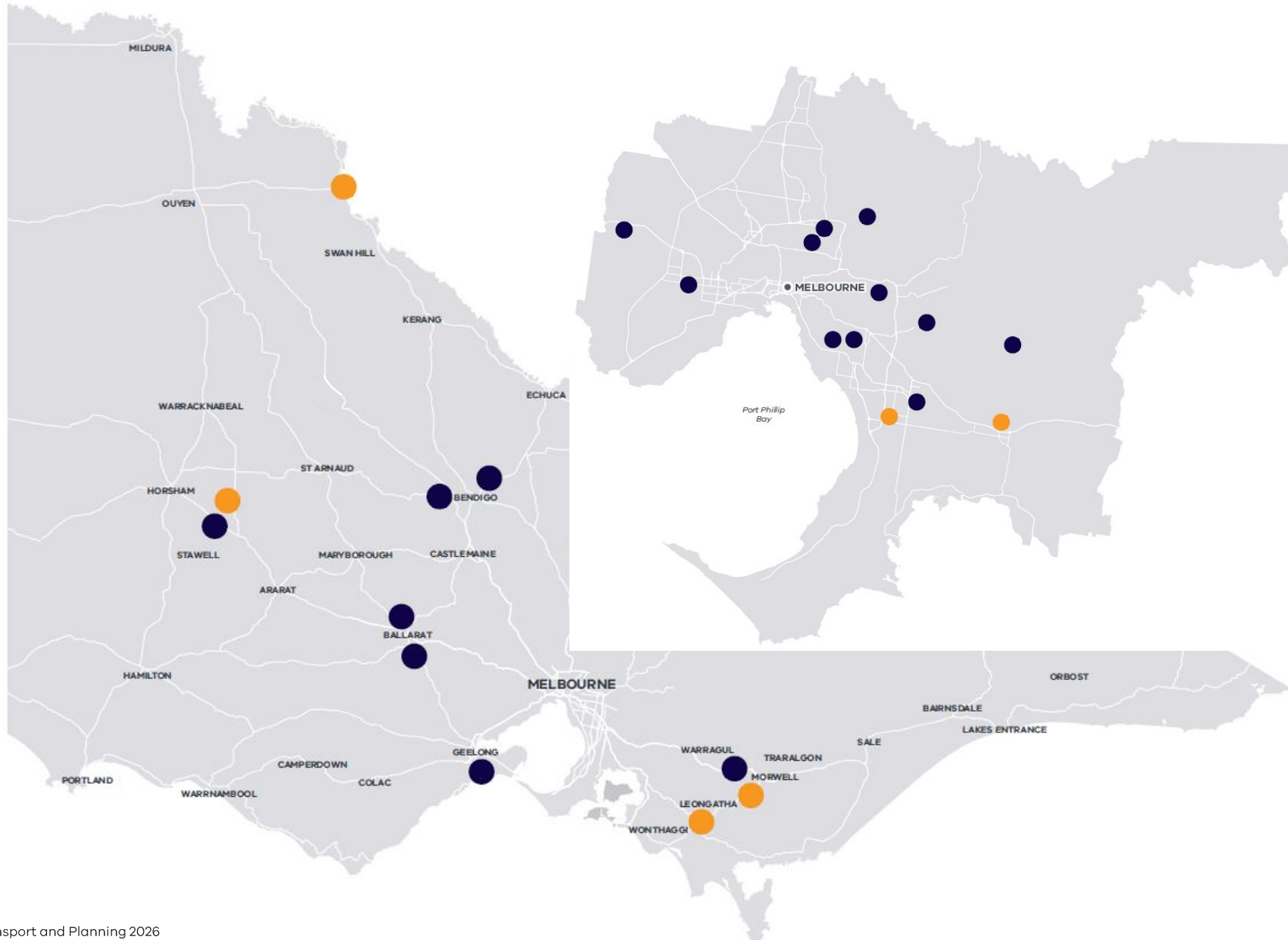


Renewing and repairing our roads

- More than \$1 billion will be invested to renew and repair Victorian roads in *Victorian Budget 2026/27* – our largest ever investment.
- 70% will be spent maintaining the state's road network in regional Victoria.
- Crews continue to deliver last budget's \$976 million Better Roads Blitz – with thousands of on-road works underway or already completed.
- The \$36.9 million roadside cleaning blitz will deliver increased maintenance to roadsides – including additional rubbish and graffiti removal, mowing and more.

Delivering safer roads for Victoria

- The Victorian Government is continuing to deliver the Road Safety Action Plan 2.
- More than \$1.1 billion will be invested to halve deaths and reduce road trauma by 2030.
- \$16.8 million will be invested towards the School Crossing Supervisor program in *Victorian Budget 2026/27*.
- This investment will allow the ongoing supervision of over 3,000 school crossings in Victoria.



Safe Local Roads and Streets Program

- A further \$28.7 million has been directed towards the Safe Local Roads and Streets Program.
- A total of \$214 million is being provided to local governments to improve road safety infrastructure.
- More than 440 projects will be delivered – including raised pedestrian crossings, intersection upgrades, speed cushions and safer speeds.
