LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AND LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.

*Resolved that—*

XXVI. In any Joint Standing Rules and Orders of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly, the words "in writing" or "written" shall be deemed to mean and include "either written or printed, or partly written and partly printed." Interpretation of words "in writing" or "written."
