STANDING ORDER.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE TO THE PRESIDENT.

CXXIV. In case of the absence of the President, with the permission of the Council, the Council shall be presided over by such other member as the Council may appoint, until the President shall have returned, or his leave of absence shall have expired, or his seat shall have become vacant.
