Committee to hear evidence on Victorian integrity agencies' performance

The Office of the Victorian Information Commissioner (OVIC), the Victorian Inspectorate (VI) and Inner Melbourne Community Legal will appear at public hearings in Melbourne on Monday 25 November 2024.

Victorian Parliament's Integrity and Oversight Committee will examine the performance of the Information Commissioner and the Victorian Inspectorate, with a focus on their 2022/23 annual reports.

The Committee has also invited Inner Melbourne Community Legal to appear at a public hearing to discuss their advocacy work with IBAC on addressing police-perpetrated family violence in Victoria.

"The Committee has already heard from the Victorian Ombudsman and IBAC and will now hear from OVIC and the VI, as well as Inner Melbourne Community Legal—as part of the Committee's oversight of IBAC," said the Committee Chair, Dr Tim Read.

The hearing will commence at 1:30 pm and continue to approximately 3:45 pm.
