Carers' facility



- A new carers' facility at Parliament House has been opened, named after Charlotte Marshall
- Charlotte Marshall was allowed to stay in the chamber on 18 March 2003 as she was fed by her mother, former Forest Hill MP Kirstie Marshall after a landmark ruling by then Speaker Judy Madigan
- 'Charlotte's Room' provides a dedicated space for all members to provide care for their young children

- More than 450 teachers and pre-service teachers participated in our professional development programs on civics education
- Our social media content on committees, legislation, MPs and community activities reached more than 2 million people across various channels
- Young people produced a variety of content for our website and social media through programs such as Youth Associates, Parliament Express and Unpack Parliament





Commonwealth Parliamentary Association
