1. **The CHAIR, p. 24**

Question Asked:

Bronwen FitzGERALD: Yes. I think the VECRA witnesses who you heard from previously would have mentioned an authorised officer number. There are other staff that do investigations and other specialist activity that are in addition to that to those 90 authorised officers, so the staffing transfers, both the authorised officers and the head office investigations and enforcement and licensing staff.

The CHAIR: Would we be able to get a breakdown of that on notice?

Bronwen FitzGERALD: I am sure we can provide that.

The CHAIR: If there were any executive team members that moved across, how many authorised officers and, like you said, investigations team –

Bronwen FitzGERALD: Yes, and the specialist staff.

The CHAIR: Yes, specialist staff. Thank you.

Response:

The Victorian Early Childhood Regulatory Authority's (VECRA's) total funded employees are now approximately 350 full-time equivalent (FTE) positions, which includes:

- approximately 180 Authorised Officer positions
- approximately 170 positions to undertake critical regulatory work, including legal, investigations, enforcement, licensing, sector communications, data, information management and sharing as well as a small number of corporate staff.

In November 2025 during Legislative Council debate on the *Victorian Early Childhood Regulatory Authority Bill*, the Department of Education advised the Minister for Children that there were 242 total funded employees in the Quality Assessment and Regulation Division (QARD), which reflected additional investment announced in August 2025. Subsequent investment has increased the approximate total funded employees to the current 350.

As at 31 December 2025, there were approximately 170 FTE QARD staff on pay in filled positions who transferred to VECRA at establishment on 1 January 2026. Of these 170 FTE staff, there were:

Question Asked:

But you said there were 90 of those?

Bronwen FitzGERALD: That is correct, yes. On the 242 – and we can take this on notice, Ms Crozier, to clarify the specifics ...

Georgie CROZIER: No, no. The question was – and I will repeat it for you – to your knowledge, how many employees were at QARD? It was not about ongoing recruitment; it was about how many at QARD. The answer was 242, the minister's response – very cut and clean. In relation to the 90 authorised officers at QARD, that is 152 staff. What were they doing?

Bronwen FitzGERALD: As I said earlier, those staff are the staff that support the authorised officer workforce –

Georgie CROZIER: What, nearly two staff to support one authorised officer?

Bronwen FitzGERALD: As I said, I think we will need to take on notice and give you a breakdown of how we made up that –

Question Asked:

...Has the department done any research around the fact that childcare centres will be closing and what the implication is in relation to those fees and charges of that compliance burden that is occurring? I am not for a minute saying that there should not be compliance, but the actual burden being placed on these centres.

...

Can we then have that modelling? Can you present that to this inquiry, please?

Tony BATES: We can give a summary.

Melina BATH: Yes, per sector. Is that an average? Is that an average, or is it depending on the sector? We heard before that –

Tony BATES: Yes, for the not-for-profit smaller sector it is more at that 10 to 15 cents per day, and then for the larger for-profit providers it is more like 30 cents per day. But we can provide the committee on notice with that summary of the impact by size and by their profit or not-for-profit status.

Melina BATH: And also the modelling that you have done: how did you model that? What was the rationale behind the modelling? Some detail around how you have come to those figures.

Tony BATES: Yes, we can describe the method we used in the modelling.

Response:

DE modelling approach:

- The Department of Education (DE) used the Commonwealth Child Care Subsidy¹ and the National Quality Agenda IT System² datasets to estimate the **average revenue** per-child, per-day, and **average percentage of revenue in annual service fees** by care type in Victoria.

Per-day estimates:

- DE estimates that fee increases will cost providers, on average, between 4 cents and 31 cents per-child, per-day (Table 1).

Question Asked:

...Has the government taken modelling – and you talked about childcare deserts, and we certainly have those in regional Victoria. But in relation to OSHC, what about those service closures? Has the department done any modelling to see what are at risk of closing? Because clearly this has a huge impact where there are thin markets in regional Victoria, but not only, where you have got closure of potentially these services, and that has an impact on families to actually hold down a job. Has the department done any work on that, and if so, can you please provide that? And I would like it in relation to regulatory increases, like cost burdens, if you could.

Response:

Question Asked:

...do you have a list, a breakdown, of grants that are provided? You just said that you could do that across the regions; if there is a breakdown of those, that would be handy.

Tony BATES: Yes, we can provide on notice the type of OSHC support payments we have.

Response:

The Department of Education recognises the important role of Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) in providing quality care for children, and in supporting families and carers to manage their work, education and training commitments.

The Department provides funding to support OSHC provision through three initiatives - Small and Regional Schools, High Intensity Outside School Hours Care and Specialist Schools.

Small and Regional Schools

The Small and Regional Schools initiative aims to ensure continuing access to OSHC services at small schools (below 200 enrolments) and rural/regional schools delivering primary education across Victoria. The funding is not intended to cover the entire cost of OSHC delivery. Rather, it provides supplementary funding additional to the income the service generates from attendance fees from families using the service.

High Intensity Outside School Hours Care

The High Intensity Outside School Hours Care initiative delivers OSHC to children and young people with disabilities at 31 Victorian government specialist schools for free. High Intensity OSHC services run with high staff educator to child ratios, which means that the services are able to meet the needs of all the children who attend, ensuring safety, quality programming and activities.

Specialist Schools

The Specialist Schools initiative provides funding to support Child Care Subsidy-funded OSHC delivery at 5 specialist schools in Victoria: Hamlyn Views School, Southern Autistic School, Ngurruga School, Dharra School, and Nganboo Borron School.

A list of the OSHC initiative funding received by schools in the 2026 school year is provided in **Table 3**.
