### Ambulance Victoria inquiry hearings continue Friday

Ambulance Victoria and the Department of Health are set to give evidence to the inquiry into issues impacting the management and functions of the emergency service.

The Legislative Council Legal and Social Issues Committee will live broadcast its latest public hearing from 8:30 am on Friday 20 June 2025.

Multiple representatives of Ambulance Victoria are scheduled to appear before the Committee throughout the day, including interim Chief Executive Officer Andrew Crisp.

Various directors of a range of different departments within the emergency service are also due at the inquiry which has been examining issues related to call taking, dispatch, ambulance ramping, working conditions and workloads of paramedics, procurement practices, allegations of fraud and embezzlement, governance and accountability and the workplace culture within Ambulance Victoria.

The Committee received 189 submissions which have been published online.
